Academic Objectives to include but not limited to:

Language Arts: to include reading, spelling, grammar, and writing:

We will continue a daily literature rich reading program to include a wide variety of genres; non-fiction, fiction, biography, poetry, etc. Suzie will read silently for 30 minutes a day and out loud for 15 to 20 minutes a day. We will continue to improve her rate of speed, expression, and comprehension in the area of oral reading and silent reading skills. We will continue to use contextual clues and phonics skills to expand reading comprehension and vocabulary. An emphasis will be placed on learning vocabulary across the curriculum.

Suzie will begin to develop a writer's voice through regular written compositions. She will improve her spelling proficiency through regular weekly spelling drills and tests. We will continue to master library and research skills. She will write her first research paper.

Mathematics:

Suzie will continue to learn the basic concepts of elementary arithmetic; adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing. She will continue to explore, estimations, place value to 1,000,000, problem solving with basic fraction, and standards of measurement. She will continue to learn about graphs, charts and maps as well, as be able to translate the information given in these forms.

History:

History will include (but not limited to) the study of Pennsylvania and the United States in Colonial America; and geography of our Nation.

Science:

Suzie will begin the study of the human body, plants and animals, weather, and how to classify invertebrates.

Physical Education:

Suzie will continue to value and demonstrate good sportsmanship as she plays on recreational sports teams in our district. She will continue to be active outside riding her bicycle, climbing trees, swinging, running and practicing softball, and lacrosse.
